Dear NRA Member and fellow Friends of the NRA:

The Greater Triangle Friends of the NRA cordially invites you to its 2010 Annual Friends of the NRA Fund-raising Event. The event will start at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, March 31, 2010, at The Wake County Shrine Club, 6015 Lead Mine Road, Raleigh, North Carolina. Our guest speaker will be Jim Land, Secretary of the National Rifle Association of America.

You may participate by purchasing banquet tickets for \$35 each. You may become a Sponsor of the Event for \$250 in addition to buying a banquet ticket. If you become a Sponsor, you will have a one-in-ten chance to win one of a fine selection of Sponsor guns. **Sponsors do not have to be present to win sponsor guns! We had 140 sponsors for last year's event. We gave away 14 Sponsor Guns!**

The first six Sponsor guns are: **(1) Colt Accurized Rifle .223 Flat Top Receiver w/24" SS Barrel, (2) BlackWater custom made AR15, (3) Ruger SR-556 .223 Rem rifle w/3 30rd mags, (4) Kimber 84M Varmint .22-250, (5) Springfield Standard M1A Rifle .308 Win, (6) Kimber SS Pro Carry II in .45 ACP. We will have one Sponsor gun for every 10 Sponsors.**

As a special incentive, we will have a "First Shot" drawing for those who purchase their banquet tickets (post marked) by March 1, 2010. Those purchasing a banquet ticket before March 1, 2010, will have his/her name entered in the "First Shot" drawing for a **Marlin model XL7 30-06 Bolt Action rifle.**

The 2010 Gun of the Year is a **Kimber 84M Classic Select Grade .308 WIN Rifle.**

Here is a list of a few of our bucket raffle guns for this year's event: **A Remington 700 SPS .300 Win Mag. We have an M & P .40SW w/15 rd mag, a Taurus Judge .410/.45 Colt, and a Weatherby PA-08 pump 12 Ga. Shotgun** along with several other assorted rifles, shotguns, and handguns.

We are looking forward to having you attend this year's FNRA Fund-raising Event, so complete your First Shot form now and participate in what is sure to be the most talked-about event of the year! It is your opportunity to pick up some one-of-a-kind items, have a great meal, and help ensure the future of the shooting sports.

As you know, our Committee provides a pretty high ratio of quality handguns on both the Sponsor table and on the Bucket Raffle table. This means your chances of winning a handgun as versus a long gun are high. As a "value add" to the quality of the firearms we offer, we have Federal Firearms Licensees at the banquet to transfer the firearms to you that night. This extra effort is defeated when the winner of a handgun cannot accept it at the banquet. We ask, therefore, that you come prepared to accept handguns at the banquet by having either a current North Carolina Concealed Handgun Permit or a couple of valid Handgun Purchase Permits with you when you arrive.

All sales are final. Banquet Tickets will be mailed to your address and Sponsor items will be available for pickup at the door the night of the event unless you request to pick them up before the event. **Bucket Raffle tickets will be available at the door only and Bucket raffle winners must be present to win!**

All participants should be prepared to take their gun winnings home the night of the event by bringing a NC concealed carry permit or a valid pistol permit issued by their sheriff. Long gun winners without a concealed carry permit or valid pistol permit will have to wait for an instant background check. All gun winners who are not able to take home their gun(s) the night of the event will have until June 30, 2010 (90 days) to claim their winnings at Carolina Outdoor Sportsman at 2411 East Millbrook Rd. Raleigh, NC 919-676-6799. There will be a transfer fee at a reduced price of \$25 for each gun when it is claimed. If the gun is not claimed within 90 days (6/30/10) the gun will become the property of the GTFNRA and will be used next year.
